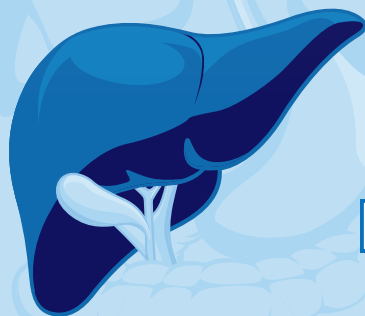
Diagnosis & management of PBC in general practice
